







This graphic presents the results of a survey commissioned by the Irish Pharmaceutical Healthcare Association to examine and measure the public's opinions of a potential future vaccine for COVID-19.

The survey was conducted via telephone by Ipsos MRBI from 15th – 30th June 2020 with a nationally representative sample of 979 adults aged 18 and over.
